Note: We will charge, based on the actual number of prints scanned, the lower of 39 cents per scan (49 cents for 600 dpi) or the Value Pack price, based on the quantity range. To get the best value, it is best to have a quantity of prints to be scanned near the top of the quantity range. But be careful about going over as this can put you into the next higher quantity range.

### RESTRICTIONS:

Loose Photo Prints Only (no albums, frames, backings, adhesive tape, etc.)

Auto-Feed-able (not torn, folded, sticky, overly stiff/flimsy, odd-shape, etc.)

Photo Size (inches): minimum 2 x 2.5, maximum 8 x 12 (may be re-arranged by size)

ANY PHOTOS THAT DO NOT MEET THE ABOVE RESTRICTIONS WILL BE SKIPPED OR SCANNED AT THE SPECIAL HANDLING PRICE OF \$3.50 PER PICTURE. (CUSTOMER CHOICE, ASSUMING SCANNING IS POSSIBLE)

Photos may be left in their original processing envelopes to maintain grouping of photos

### **All work done in-house:**

Some companies ship your precious photos across the country, or even to other continents, to keep their processing costs low. Your prints will never leave our site for processing. And while they are here, we take care of them as if they were our own.

### **How to choose between 300 or 600 dpi:**

The level of detail contained in your photo prints can vary greatly. Some have no more than 200 to 300 dpi (dots per inch) of detail, while others, depending on the quality of the original camera, processing and paper used, may have as much as 600 dpi of detail. It is safest to use 600 dpi scanning to ensure getting virtually all of the detail available on the picture. However, if you know your photos are poorly focused, or otherwise lacking in sharp details, choosing 300 dpi may be appropriate and save you a little money. Be aware, however, that the age of the photo may not be a good indicator. Some older photos, even if faded, may have a great deal of detail that you will want to retain. As well, smaller photos, such as “wallet sized” photos may be better to scan at 600 dpi as this will allow the picture to display larger on a typical computer screen.

## **DIGITAL PHOTOS TO DVD**

Access video can transfer your digital photos (from a digital camera or previously scanned prints) to a video on DVD and VHS tape.
